



# Final Army Base Stripped of Confederate Name

The names of Confederate leaders who took up arms against the United States in the Civil War have been fully stripped from Army installations, as the former Fort Gordon in Georgia was renamed Fort Eisenhower on October 27.

A ceremony marking the name change was held on the post's parade grounds, a location where Eisenhower as president conducted his final review of troops as commander in chief in January 1961.

The following Army installations also received new names this year:

- Fort Barfoot, Virginia, formerly Fort Pickett.
- Fort Novosel, Alabama, once Fort Rucker.
- Fort Gregg-Adams, Virginia, once Fort Lee.
- Fort Cavazos, Texas, once Fort Hood.
- Fort Liberty, North Carolina, formerly Fort Bragg
- Fort Johnson, Louisiana, transitioned from Fort Polk
- Fort Walker, Virginia, formerly Fort A. P. Hill
- Louisiana National Guard Training Center-Pineville was formerly Camp Beauregard.


